

Summer Reading for Grades 4-6

May 2009

Purpose

The incoming 4th - 6th Grade will complete a summer reading program to maintain fluency and reading levels and to encourage independent reading.

Requirement I

The student must read the book listed by incoming grade level and follow the specific directions.

4th Grade:

Tales of 4th Grade Nothing by Judy Blume

- A comprehension activity, led by the 4th grade teachers, will take place the first week of school.

5th Grade:

Where The Red Fern Grows by Wilson Rawls

- A comprehension activity, led by the 5th grade teachers, will take place the first week of school.

6th Grade:

The Egypt Game by Zilpha Keatley Snyder

- Students will be assigned a project during the first week of school.
- It is suggested, but not required, that students take notes over important events and characters in the book. Especially, if they read the book early in the summer.
