

## Summer Reading for Grades 3-6

May 2010

### Purpose

The incoming 3<sup>rd</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> Grade will complete a summer reading program to maintain fluency and reading levels and to encourage independent reading.

### Requirement I for 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade

The student must read the book listed by incoming grade level and follow the specific directions.

#### 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade:

Freckle Juice by Judy Blume

- A comprehension activity, led by the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade teachers, will take place the first week of school.

#### 4<sup>th</sup> Grade:

Tales of 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Nothing by Judy Blume

- A comprehension activity, led by the 4<sup>th</sup> grade teachers, will take place the first week of school.

#### 5<sup>th</sup> Grade:

Tuck Everlasting by Natalie Babbitt

- A comprehension activity, led by the 5<sup>th</sup> grade teachers, will take place the first week of school.

#### 6<sup>th</sup> Grade:

Loser by Jerry Spinelli

- Students should be prepared for a test over the book during the first week of school.
- It is suggested, but not required, that students take notes over important events in the book. Especially, if they read the book early in the summer.
